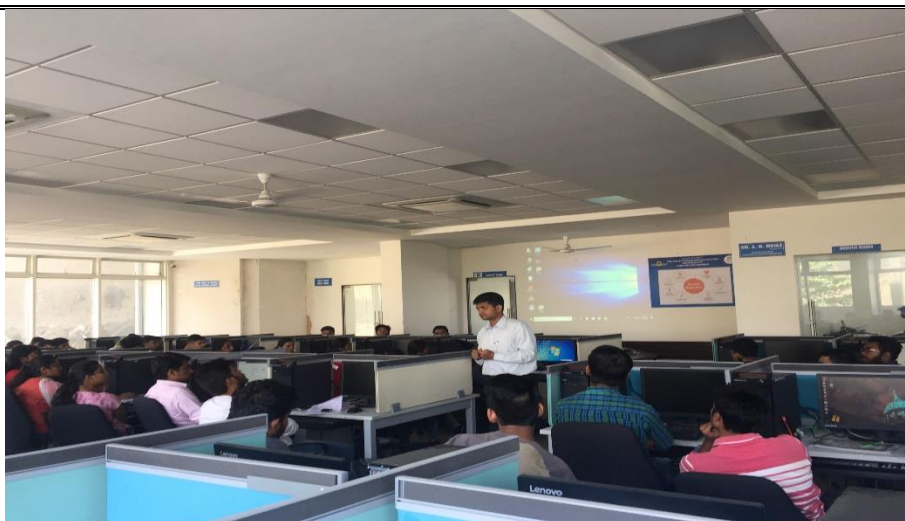
In the morning session 101 students and 6 faculty members were present and in the afternoon session 77 students were present. After completion of the program feedback from students was taken.
