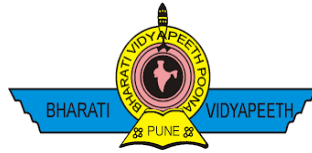
A REPORT ON POSTER AND PAINTING EXHIBITION

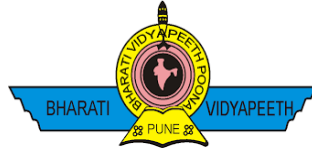

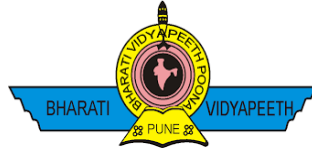
