While working on student internship for civil engineering students, Builders' Association of India (BAI), Pune Centre was approached with an objective of exploring possibility of placing some of our students for internship with various builders/ developers in Pune. The contact person was Mr. ManojDeshmukh, Hon. Joint Secretary, Builders' Association of India (Pune Centre). While briefing about why BAI have initiated student internship programme from the year 2015-16, he said that most of the builders felt that when a fresh civil engineer is recruited, he lacks the right attitude that is required for the work he is expected to do.

The students of our college learn about different types of Soft Skills and Employable Skill Development as subjects in second and third year of their curriculum. It was felt that it would be beneficial to our students if someone like Mr. Deshmukh comes to our college and talk to them about what construction industry expects from the fresh civil engineers. The lecture was attended by Second, Third and Final year students of Civil Engineering. All the faculty members of the Department and T & P Officer of the College were also present.
